



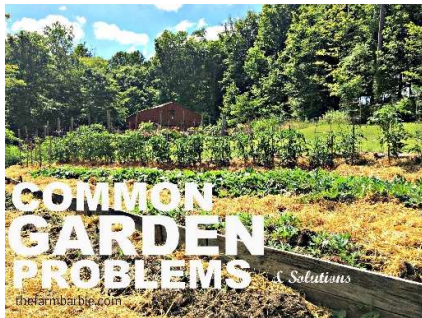
EASTER weekend falls early this year – did you know the *most* common dates that Easter Sunday has occurred are 28th and 31st March?
